# Shuttles in the Seaport

- Promote mode shift and reduce single-occupancy vehicles trips in the Seaport
- Last-mile connections between Seaport, North Station & South Station
- Fill in transit demand gaps in the Flynn Marine Park and A Street
- Ferries play a similar role – East Boston connection

# Shuttle Consolidation

- Goals:
  - Fewer vehicles circulating the neighborhood
  - Public access
  - Greater efficiency
  - Less conflict at the curb
- Shuttle consolidation laid the groundwork for North Station and East Boston ferry services

# Seaport Circulator

- **Access** - connect residents and commuters with housing and employment
- **Convenience** - Our goal is to provide 10-minute headways during peak commute hours
- **Equity** - Free and open to the public
